Launching competitive examination for admission into the Regional Training Centre of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies at Buea for the 2024-2025 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Mindful of the constitution;

Mindful of decree No.092/050 of 24th March 1992 instituting the statute of National Advanced School of Posts and Telecommunications;

Mindful of decree No.2011/408 of 9th December 2011 organising the Government;

Mindful of decree No.2011/410 of 9th December 2011 appointing the members of government;

Mindful of decree No.2012/512 of 12th April 2012 organising the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications;

Mindful of decree No.2016/425 of 26th October 2016 changing the denomination and reorganizing The National Advanced School of Posts and Telecommunications;

Mindful of decree No.2017/594 of 04th December 2017 appointing the Director and the deputy Director of the National Advanced School of the Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies;

Mindful of decree No.2019/002 of 04th January 2019 to reshuffle the Government;

Mindful of Resolution No. 41/CD/2020 of December 18, 2020, relating to the diploma required for the entrance examination to a SUP'PTIC training cycle.

On the proposal of the Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies.

ORDERS:

ARTICLE 1: Competitive entrance examinations for the admission of **Postal Clerks and Assistant Telecommunications Technicians** at the Regional Training Centre of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies Buea shall be written on the **13th and 14th of August 2024** at all Regional headquarters: **Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde.**

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR WRITING

1- Assistant Telecommunications Technicians (ATT)

- Should be male or female, aged 14 years at least as from the 1st January 2024;

- Should be a holder of the B.E.P.C., GCE “O Level” in four sciences subjects excluding Religious Knowledge, GCE “O Level” technical, C.A.P, City and Guilds Part I, Intermediate Technical Certificate or any recognised equivalent certificate.

2- Postal Clerks (AEPT)

- Should be male or female, aged 14 years at least as from the 1st January 2024;
- Should be a holder of the B.E.P.C., GCE “O Level”, GCE “O Level” technical, C.A.P. or any recognised equivalent certificate.

ARTICLE 3: NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE

The number of places available per cycle is as follow;

❖ Cameroonian Candidates:

- Assistant Telecommunications Technicians (ATT): **50 places**
- Postal Clerks (AEPT): **45 places**

❖ Armed Forces and Police candidates

- Assistant Telecommunications Technicians (ATT): **05 places**
- Postal Clerks (AEPT): **05 places**

❖ Foreign Candidates

- Assistant Telecommunications Technicians (ATT): **05 places**
- Postal Clerks (AEPT): **05 places**

ARTICLE 4: CONTENT OF CANDIDATE’S FILE

Candidate’s file which must be submitted at SUP’PTIC of Yaounde, Regional Training Centre of Buea or all Posts and Telecommunications Regional Delegations except Yaounde and Buea on the **09th August 2024** latest, shall be made up of the following documents:

- An application form to be collected from all the Regional Delegations of Posts and telecommunications except Yaounde and Buea, the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies of Yaounde, the Regional Training Centre of Buea or the website **www.e-supptic.cm**.
- A payment receipt of **15,000FCFA**, in any Post office to the accountant of SUP’PTIC (Account number **150657330-19**);
- A certified true copy of birth certificate not more than 03 Months old from the date of certification;
- A certified true copy of the required certificate;
- A school attendance certificate for candidates still expecting the results of the required certificate;
- A medical certificate of fitness for working in the Posts and telecommunications sector, issued by a public medical practitioner;
- Two (02) passport size photographs (4x4);
- A certified true copy of the National Identity card;
- A self-addressed stamped envelope (**500 F CFA** Postal Stamp).

ARTICLE 13: Foreign students shall sit for special examinations organised by the Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies.

ARTICLE 14: The Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies is charged with the implementation of this decision, which shall be registered, published and broadcast in both English and French wherever need be./- ✎
